



## **Tasting of the vintage 2007**

### **Meursault**

Nice pale yellow colour. Discreet aromas of peach, apricot, spices and menthol. Spicy flavors with notes of peach and honey. Tense and penetrating wine.

### **Meursault Blagny 1<sup>er</sup> Cru**

Pale, bright yellow. Nice nose of citrus, pear and menthol. Densely packed, juicy and downright, with good energy to its lemon and crushed stone flavors. Finishes long and quite firm, in need of patience.

### **Meursault Charmes 1<sup>er</sup> Cru**

Bright medium yellow. Aromas of lemon, fresh apricot and crushed stone. Then rich, dense and fruity, with an enveloping and silky texture. As generous as this is in the early going, its structure suggests it will show more opulence and a great potential with a few years of patience.

### **Meursault Perrières 1<sup>er</sup> Cru**

Musky grapefruit and wet stone on the reticent nose. Silky, dense and ripe with high-pitched crushed stone and pink grapefruit flavors. Wonderfully pure, dry, rocky wine with a long, rising finish. In its infancy today.

### **Puligny-Montrachet 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Les Chalumeaux**

Complex, delicate nose melds peach, red grapefruit, clove, menthol, almond and white flowers. Penetrating, tense, lively and beautiful minerality. Youthfully austere and classically dry on the back end, hiding more than it's showing today but long on the aftertaste.

### **Puligny-Montrachet 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Les Combettes**

Bright, pale yellow. Captivating aromas of grapefruit, pineapple, clove, acacia flower and crushed stone. Juicy, pure and sweet, beautiful maturity, mineral-driven. The juicy flavors of pineapple, grapefruit and crushed stone are at once delicate and strong. Finishes quite suave, and not at all austere for an appellation that's built to age. Lovely balance.



**DOMAINE MATROT**  
MEURSAULT

**Bourgogne Pinot Noir**

Beautiful example of Pinot Noir with a concentrated vintage. Powerful tannic structure which will make it more gourmand after one or two years of patience.

**Meursault Rouge**

The aromas of red fruits dominate the tannins. Nice maturity, very elegant wine. Will be more pleasant within two years.

**Monthélie**

A basket of red fruits, we find the freshness of the Pinot Noir in its most beautiful expression. It will be ready to drink next summer.

**Auxey-Duresses**

Aromas of dark and red fruits, beautiful maturity. Powerful tannins, needs two or three years of patience.

**Volnay Santenots 1<sup>er</sup> Cru**

Beautiful complexity. Pleasant aromas of red fruits. Nice structure and length. Need three to five years of patience to really enjoy this wine.

**Blagny La pièce sous le Bois 1<sup>er</sup> Cru**

The terroir expresses itself perfectly with aromas of dark fruits, liquorice and spices. Very ripe tannins. Very beautiful potential for ageing.
